On June 10, 2007 we were honored to meet Angela Shelton, actress turned activist. Safe-House sponsored a screening of the movie, Searching For Angela Shelton at the Ann Arbor Public Library. Just prior to entering the screening room, we were lucky enough to be standing right by Angela herself, and we got the opportunity to introduce ourselves and tell her about Women For Hope. We

also presented her with one of our Sexual Assault Awareness Bracelets, which she was thrilled to receive.

Angela introduced the movie. which is a documentary that she wrote, directed and edited. She started out attempting to meet with and interview all the Angela Shelton's across the country, with the purpose of doing a documentary about women in America. She literally looked up all the Angela Shelton's on AOL City Guide and found there were 70. She ended up speaking to over 40 and discovered that 24 of those women were either raped. molested or beaten. The documentary took a swift turn in focus to become a voice for women who have never had a chance to tell their stories. Angela is a survivor of incest. As she travels across the country meeting these amazing women, she realizes she needs to confront her own abuser, her father. It is a powerful and gritty film, but in the end it shows that there is hope, and that speaking out helps to heal.

After the movie, Angela answered questions and shared some coping techniques. We were certainly touched to see her proudly wearing the bracelet we gave her.

If you ever get a chance to see her speak or even just see the movie, we highly recommend doing so.
